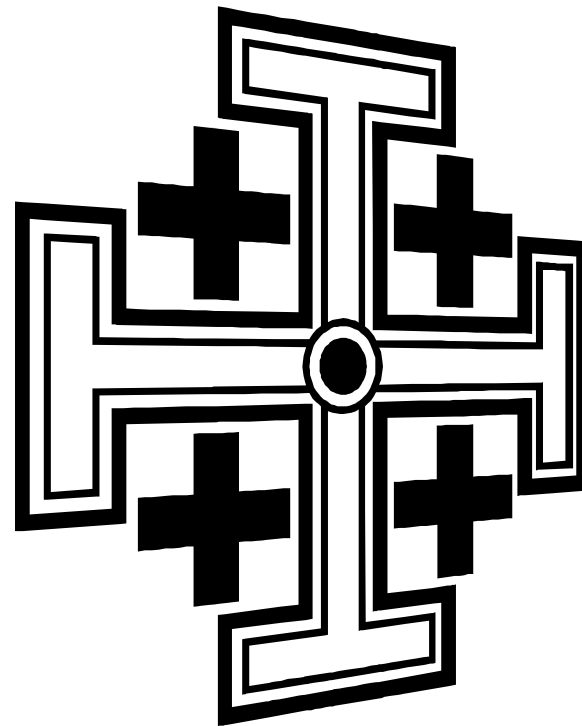

Retreat Director:

Fr. Bill Burton, OFM, is a Franciscan priest of the Sacred Heart Province. He lives at their friary called "Antonianum" (in honor of St. Anthony of Padua, the great preacher and contemporary of St. Francis of Assisi) in Chicago with three other friars.

He has an M. Div. from Catholic Theological Union in Chicago and an M.A. in Theology, also from Catholic Theological Union. He received a Licentiate in Sacred Scripture (SSL) from the Pontifical Biblical Institute in Rome and a doctorate (STD) from the Pontifical Gregorian University, also in Rome. In 2002, he received a M. Ed. in Higher Education Administration from Loyola University, Chicago.

He has taught undergraduate and graduate courses in Biblical Studies at Quincy University, Quincy, Illinois and undergraduate courses at DePaul University in Chicago.

He is a member of the Society of Biblical Literature, the College Theology Society and the Catholic Biblical Association. He has delivered several academic papers at the College Theology Society and has published an article in *The Bible Today* (July/August, 2006).

He has traveled extensively and studied arduously through Israel/Palestine, Turkey, Egypt, Greece and Italy where he lived for almost seven years. Thanks to his education he is able to work with the biblical texts in their original languages: Hebrew, Aramaic and Greek.
